

Community Health Registered Nurse Part Time (24 HOURS/WEEK)

Job Overview:

We are seeking an energetic, passionate and community-focused Registered Nurse to lead our mobile vaccine program, serving local DC residents, including children. Based at our office in Langston Terrace, this part-time role is an excellent opportunity to make a meaningful impact by overseeing mobile vaccination and promoting public health outreach, planning, and education across the broader community.

Community Health Nurse Responsibilities:

- Enrolling in the Vaccines for Children (VFC) program with DC Health as a lead vaccine coordinator
- Administering vaccines and providing health education as part of a mobile clinic team, with a focus on serving children and families in DC neighborhoods.
- Conducting patient assessments, addressing vaccine-related questions, and ensuring informed consent.
- Collaborating with schools, families, and community organizations to plan and execute vaccination events.
- Maintaining accurate vaccine administration records and documentation in the electronic health record (EHR) system.
- Supporting follow-up care and connecting individuals to additional healthcare resources when needed.
- Organizing and participating in community health promotion activities related to immunizations and disease prevention.
- Mentoring and coordinating with community health workers to enhance outreach and engagement efforts.
- Staying informed about vaccine protocols, public health trends, and community health initiatives.
- Ensuring adherence to and completion of all clinical documentation following agency protocol and Medicaid/Medicare/Federal guidelines.

Community Health Nurse Requirements:

- Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) preferred.
- Active DC State-licensed Registered Nurse (RN).
- Education or experience in public health or community nursing.
- 2-5 years of experience in community or public health, particularly with vaccination programs, preferred.
- Proficiency in electronic health record (EHR) management systems.
- Commitment to addressing healthcare disparities and serving diverse populations.
